PROGRAMS OFFERED

Breaking the Rules of Modern Tribalism: It is so much more comfortable being with your "own kind." But what are we missing, as individuals and as a society, when we simply follow the rules of "This is what we do, who we know; those are not"?

Building a Richer Society: A healthy, growing economy requires creative problem solving, innovative development, and being open to new ideas and new ways of thinking. How can we mine the wealth of our diversity to ensure our future as a culture and an economy?

The Creative Life: How can we strive for something beyond ourselves, for a connection that we can create between the self and the other, through art, through a considered life, through reaching beyond what is to what could be?

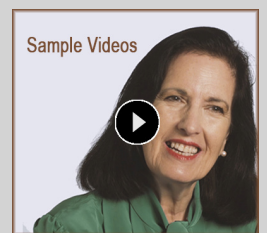
Reaching Across the Ethnic/Racial Divide: A interactive workshop exploring methods to use when approaching strangers, and how to make connections when walls exist among people.

Talk with Sally about customizing a program for your school, company, organization, book club or fund-raiser.

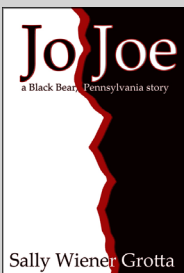
